### Observe & Interpret

Read 2 Samuel 11-12 Summarize the passages in your own words.

### Person Reflection Questions

#### From Chapter 11 (Spiral of Sin)

1. Where are you “lingering in dangerously isolated positions”?
2. Are you somewhere you shouldn’t be—physically, emotionally, mentally, digitally?
3. Are there compromises — small ones — that you’ve been treating as harmless?
4. Who has God put in your life to warn you... and are you listening?

#### From 12:1-13 (Lessons from David’s Repentance)

1. When was the last time you truly confessed without defending yourself?
2. Is there a sin you’ve been minimizing or excusing that you need to own before God today?
3. Are you more concerned with managing consequences than with being right with God?
4. What would it look like for you to pray Psalm 51 from the heart this week?

### Application

1. How can our group be a place of honesty, accountability, and grace?
2. What is one specific way you will resist temptation or confess sin this week?
3. How does this story ultimately point us to Jesus, the one who takes our sin upon Himself and offers full forgiveness?

### Prayer Focus

- Thank God for His mercy and grace in Jesus Christ.
- Pray for honesty in confessing sin and courage to repent.
- Ask God to strengthen one another to resist temptation and walk in holiness.
