Big Idea: Christians approach challenges by remembering the works of God, relying on the words of God, and responding with the worship of God.

Key Sermon Text: 2 Chronicles 20:1–30

- 3. How can you begin to let the words of God give you encouragement and hope in challenges?
- 4. Who or what are you quick to give credit to when you experience deliverance or freedom from hardship?
- 5. What does praise look like in your life? What are different ways you can praise God outside of Sunday mornings?
