

"And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."





Q14 Do you have any friends who have struggled with their gender identity?







Q9 What level of commitment do you need with someone before you'd consider sexual activity?




Q7 Have you had any sexual experiences? (oral sex, intercourse, etc.)
