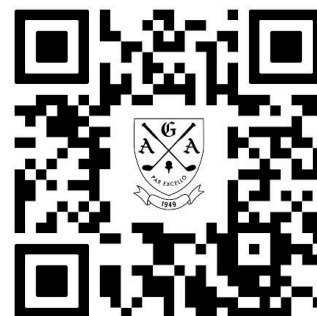

Rules of Play:

USGA Rules will govern play along with these additional local rules:

1. Lift, Clean, & Place, **Length of Score card** in any closely mown areas **ON YOUR OWN HOLE**
2. Newly sodded areas: Player has the option to free relief, 1 club length, no closer to the hole. However, if the ball comes to rest in a sod seam, it is **MANDATORY** to take free relief.
3. Band area near 18 green: Line of sight relief
4. Plastic lining around newly planted trees. Free relief for stance and swing. 1 club length, no closer to the hole.

***If a Rules question arises that can't be vetted within the group, the player should play **TWO** balls thru that hole and then discuss with the Pro Shop when He turns in the score card. The Pro Shop will be the final say and apply to the score accordingly.

Other reminders:

1. **IT IS THE PLAYERS RESPONSIBILITY TO HIT FROM THE CORRECT TEE.** If you play the wrong tee and have not completed the hole, you may re-tee from the correct tee with a 2-stroke penalty. If you realize you have played the wrong tee after finishing the hole, you will record max score for that hole.
2. Halfway house is **NOT** line of sight relief, only stance and swing.
3. The 14-club rule is in effect. **COUNT YOUR CLUBS BEFORE YOU TEE OFF.** You may take a club out of play by turning it upside down in your bag.
4. The embedded ball rule is in effect through the green including in grass bunker faces. There is no relief for an embedded ball in the sand of a bunker.
5. Any putt that counts for the team score must be holed. If your score cannot help the team, please pick up. **NET DOUBLE BOGEY IS THE MAXIMUM SCORE.**
6. GPS and range finders are allowed, no slope measurements.
7. No relief from flower beds and mulch areas.
8. You must hit from 165 yards on number 6 to qualify for the Hole in One challenge.

Mulligans:

Participants may purchase 2 mulligans (1 mulligan for each day) at check in for **\$100 CASH at check-in**. When considering whether to use your mulligan, no scouting (leaving the area the shot was played) is allowed, but you may watch your partner hit his next shot.

Scoring:

One player in each foursome must keep score on the Golf Genius app AND gross scores must be recorded on paper scorecards. The paper scorecard is the official record of the round and must be signed by one member of the marker and competitor team.

In the event of a Tie:

In the event of a tie at the conclusion of the regulation play, the teams that are tied will play #18 until a Champion is determined. The format for the playoff will be (1) net best ball- Sudden Death, and appropriate handicaps will apply. If the playoff is suspended due to darkness by the tournament committee, the event will end in a tie.

Inclement Weather/Darkness:

In the event of inclement weather and the ACC weather horn blows, you MUST suspend play. Mark your ball and seek shelter immediately. Penalty or disqualification may result if you continue to play after the horn blows.

Play may also be suspended by the tournament committee due to unplayable conditions or darkness. In that event you will be notified of such suspension by text message. Otherwise, play will continue through rain and twilight if necessary (even if the party has started).

IF PLAY HAS NOT BEEN SUSPENDED, KEEP PLAYING OR RISK DISQUALIFICATION.

The tournament committee may alter the tournament format or schedule if needed due to weather.

Payouts - Day Money will only be for Saturday.
