

Anderson Valley Vineyards Fact Sheet

In 2007 the Anderson Valley Winegrowers completed a full census of all bearing vineyards (2006) within the legal definition of the Anderson Valley Appellation. Vineyards are identified through public records at the County of Mendocino, aerial photography, consultation with local vineyard management services, and through the AVWA membership lists.
