

Save Money on Your Stormwater Fee with a Volunteer Community Cleanup

Reduce Your Water Bill

An easy way to reduce your water bill is to participate in a Maryland Stormwater Participation Event and receive a credit on your stormwater fee. Reducing the polluted stormwater that flows into our storm drains, streams, and harbor helps to improve water quality and create cleaner and greener communities. You can receive a credit by participating in a registered Volunteer Community Cleanup.

Register an Event

It's simple! Just call 311 and tell the operator that you want to register a "Volunteer Community Cleanup." You will be asked to provide general event information.

Remember to register as an individual or group to become a part of the DPW Volunteer Network at www.bit.ly/volunteerDPW to get updated information, post your event on the calendar and request tools and supplies for your event.

How Stormwater Credits Work

- Through the Volunteer Network hub site, a registered volunteer who participated in a Volunteer Community Cleanup will be sent a **Stormwater Fee Credit application** and **certificate** to the email or mailing address indicated on the submitted Volunteer Registration Form.
- Volunteers earn \$10 off for each certificate. This discount can be applied up to 3 times per year (maximum of \$30 credit / year).
- Volunteers can receive more than one certificate if they have registered and participated in multiple cleanups.
- Certificates can be combined for households. For instance, a husband and wife, or mother and daughter, etc., can participate in a registered cleanup. Each participant will receive a certificate. Two certificates = \$20 credits for that one household.
- If you live in or pay for a Baltimore City water bill, you can "gift" your certificates to a City resident.
- **Credits are not automatic.** Applicants are required to complete the Stormwater Fee Credit application and submit the application and certificates to DPW, Bureau of Water and Wastewater, Abel Wolman Municipal Building, 200 Holliday Street, Room 404, Baltimore, MD 21202 Attn: Customer Support and Services Division or email your application to publicworks@baltimorecity.gov (Include in the subject line **STORMWATER CREDIT APPLICATION**)
- The credit is good for one year.
