Dear Resident,

Baltimore City Office of Engineering & Construction will be making upgrades to the water mains in your neighborhood. During the time of water main replacement, the contractor will saw cut the pavement, excavate a trench in the location of the old water main or in a new proposed location, remove the existing pipe and replace it with a new section(s) of water main pipe. The Contractor will backfill the excavation with crushed stone to prevent settlement and install temporary paving followed by future permanent pavement restoration.

During construction, residents can expect:

- Temporary above ground water main service and temporary connections of house water services may be used.
- Temporary interruption in water service. A 72-hour notification will be given to consumers prior to planned interruption in the water service via door-to-door flyer delivery.
- Temporary parking restrictions to accommodate installation equipment.
- A moderate amount noise from construction equipment, such as jackhammers, during pavement removal, excavation equipment and pumps used during water main replacement.
- Traffic control equipment and personnel (flaggers) to maintain the flow of traffic.

To assist the Contractor performing the installation, we ask that residents:

- Refrain from parking in areas posted for installation and equipment.
- Obey detours and traffic control personnel.
- Keep out of work area during active construction.

Project Background

DPW supplies drinking water to 1.8 million residents in the Metropolitan Area which encompasses 3,800 miles of water mains, 67,500 valves and 23,000 fire hydrants. DPW is responsible for maintaining the 1,500 miles of water mains located within city limits. The City is committed to renewing its aging infrastructure, which includes water mains that are nearly 100 years old.

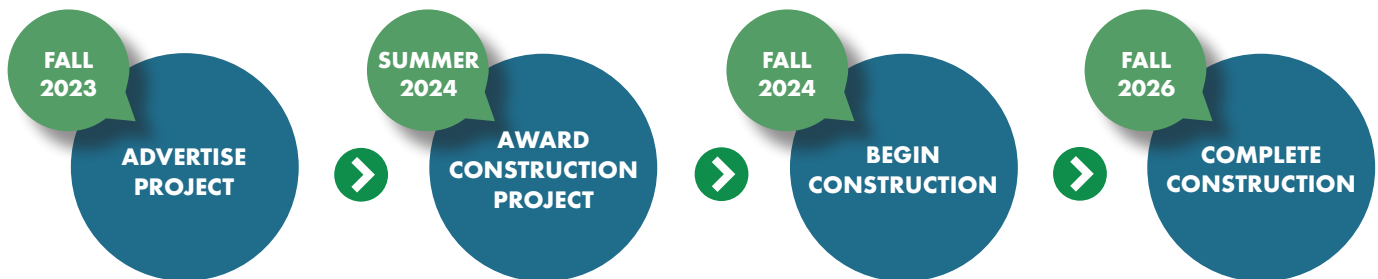
Project Purpose

- ▶ Improve water flows and water quality
- ▶ Reduce water service disruptions and costly repairs
- ▶ Minimize water main breaks
- ▶ Minimize street closures

Project Activities

- ▶ Replacement/relocation of **5.25 ±** miles of water mains
- ▶ Installation or replacement of **161 ±** valves
- ▶ Installation or replacement of **37 ±** fire hydrants
