Water Contract 1279: Sefton Area and Vicinity Water Main Replacement

June 2025

To Whom it May Concern,

Below is the project construction status update. Planned work for June 2025

Work in Progress:

- Saw cutting in preparation for pipe replacement in the 3000-3200 blocks of Evergreen Avenue, 5500-5600 blocks of Carter Avenue, and 5500-5600 blocks of Sefton Avenue
- Installation of temporary bypass piping for watermain installation in the 5500-5600 blocks of Carter Avenue, and 5500-5600 Sefton Avenue.
- Install of new ductile iron water main pipes in 3000-3200 blocks of Evergreen Avenue, 5500-5600 blocks of Carter Avenue, 5500-5600 blocks of Sefton Avenue, and 3300-3400 blocks of Mary Avenue.
- Disinfection and testing of the newly installed water mains.
- Transferring of water house connections to the newly installed water mains where disinfection and testing have been completed. You may experience a 30–60-minute service interruption when you are being connected to the new water main.
- Roadway restoration and resurfacing on 3100-3300 Hamilton Avenue, 5500 Alban Avenue, 5500 Edna Avenue, 2800-2900 Evergreen Avenue, 3000 Roselawn Avenue, 5900-6000 Edna Avenue and 3100-3200 Mary Avenue.
