Below is the project construction status update. Planned Work for June 2025

Work in Progress:

- Installation of new water main in the following blocks 2800-2900 Ridgewood Avenue, 4800-5000 Cordelia Avenue, 2800 Waldorf Avenue, 200 N Bentalou Street, 2000 Penrose Avenue, Unit-100 Smallwood Avenue, 2100-2300 West Lexington Street, and 100 Pulaski/Payson Alley.
- Installation of water service connections to the new watermain in the where water main has been installed and passed all required testing and disinfection.
- Testing and disinfection of newly installed water main. You may see surface water discharge during this testing and disinfection. This is like a running garden hose and is no cause for concern.
- Preparation and installation of roadway base and surface restoration in the following blocks 3500-3600 Manchester Avenue, 100-300 N Pulaski Avenue, 2100-2200 West Saratoga Street, and unit-100 N Bentalou.
