 - completed investigations delivered past expiration - 5 cases
 - iii. Number of cases currently scheduled for the next meeting: 16 cases (10/4)
 - iv. Number currently scheduled for the meeting after next: 18 cases (10/11)

- v. Number of cases within 15 days of expiration on the date of their scheduled hearing: 6 cases
 - of these cases, the total involving 1 accused officer: 1 case
 - involving 2-3 accused officers: 4 cases
 - involving 4-5 accused officers: 1 case
 - involving 6 or more officers: 0 cases
