As of 3:00 p.m. on February 5, 2026, the estimated numbers relating to the ACC's cases for the 2026 calendar year, excluding today's meeting, are as follows:

The estimated number of cases heard this calendar year is 85.
The estimated number of cases delivered with more than 90 days until expiration is 18.
The estimated number of cases delivered within 61 and 90 days of expiration is 23.
The estimated number of cases delivered within 31 and 60 days of expiration is 28.
The estimated number of cases delivered within 16 and 30 days of expiration is 9.
The estimated number of cases delivered within 6 and 15 days of expiration is 1.
No cases were delivered within 0 and 5 days of expiration or past their expiration.

The estimated number of cases currently scheduled for the next meeting is 26.
The estimated number of cases currently scheduled for the meeting after next is 24.
The estimated number of upcoming cases within 6 and 15 days of expiration on the date of their scheduled hearing for the next two weeks is 5.
The estimated number of upcoming cases within 0 and 5 days of expiration on the date of their scheduled hearing for the next two weeks is 2.
Of these cases, the total number involving 1 accused officer is 35; involving 2 or 3 accused officers is 13; involving 4 to 5 accused officers is 1; and involving 6 or more accused officers is 1.
