Water Contract 1349R: Madison Street Area 30 Inch Water Main Rehabilitation

February 2026

The Madison Street Area Water Main Rehabilitation Project (DPW Water Contract 1349) involves the rehabilitation of existing water mains to improve system reliability and extend the useful life of critical water infrastructure. The scope of work includes exploratory excavation to confirm existing main locations and conditions, installation of rehabilitation access structures, temporary bypass piping, and the rehabilitation of the existing water main.

Please see below for the construction status update and planned work for February 2026.:

- Installation of traffic control measures throughout the project area to safely manage pedestrian and vehicular movement around active work zones.
- Exploratory excavation to locate and verify existing water main alignment, depth, and connection points prior to rehabilitation activities.
- Installation of rehabilitation access holes to facilitate internal cleaning, inspection, and rehabilitation of the water main.
- Installation of temporary water main bypass piping to ensure uninterrupted water service to residents and businesses during the rehabilitation process.

Residents may experience periodic construction noise and temporary lane closures while crews perform this work. Access to homes and businesses will be maintained. If a brief water service interruption becomes necessary, advance notice will be provided.
