Water Contract 1283: Baltimore Street and Smallwood Street Vicinity And Reisterstown Road Vicinity Water Main Rehabilitation and Rehabilitation

March 2026

Please see below for the construction status update and planned work for March 2026.

Project Description:

DPW WC1283 Baltimore Street and Smallwood Street Vicinity and Reisterstown Road Vicinity main replacement and rehabilitation project consists of approximately 6.25 miles of aged cast iron pipe replacement with new ductile iron pipe replacement, and replacement of valves, fire hydrants, and renewal of water service connections. The WC 1283 Project begun in November of 2024 and is expected to last through November of 2026.

Water Main Installation & Service Connections

Crews will continue excavation, pipe installation, and water service connection work in the following areas:

- 2200–2400 blocks of W. Baltimore Street
- W. Lexington Street at N. Smallwood Street
- Unit block of N. Calverton Road
- 2100 block of W. Fayette Street

Restoration Activities

Roadway restoration are scheduled for the following blocks:

- 2200–2400 blocks of W. Lexington Street
- 2200 block of Vine Street
- Unit–200 block of N. Smallwood Street
- W. Lexington Street at N. Warwick Avenue

Temporary traffic modifications may occur in active work areas. Please follow posted detour signs and use caution near construction crews.

Brief water interruptions (approximately 30–60 minutes) may occur during service transfers; residents will be notified in advance whenever possible.
