To Whom it May Concern,
Below is the project construction status update. Planned Work for March 2026

Work in Progress:

- Installing new 8-inch Ductile Iron water main on the 100 block of Caroline St
- Permanent restoration services will begin mid-March to repair the roads on East Patapsco St
- Installation of new 6-inch ductile iron water main on St Joseph St between Monastery Ave and N. Culver St
- Disinfection and testing of the newly installed water mains.
- Transferring of water house connections to the newly installed water mains where disinfection and testing have been completed. You may experience a 30–60-minute service interruption when you are being connected to the new water main.
