## *Am I qualified to apply?*

- 1. Your property must be at the point of tax sale, owing over \$1,000 in back taxes (having received a final bill and legal notice from DOF)**
- 2. Must be at least 65 years of age**
- 3. Must have a household income of less than \$73k**
- 4. Home must be valued at less the \$250k**
- 5. Must be a resident of the property for at least 10 years**

## *What information do I need to bring?*

- 1. Your official government-issued ID**
- 2. Two utility bills that are addressed to you at the property address**
- 3. Proof of income for tax year 2025**
