Re: Public Information Act Fulfillment Report July 1 through Dec. 31, 2025

Starting November 2023 all public information act requests sent to the Baltimore City Office of the Comptroller are published in a report and made available quarterly on the office's website pages. The Comptroller's Office committed to this level of transparency in its January 2021 transition report.

This policy includes all public information requests from the media, public, businesses, and government entities, and cover all available responsive documents from the departments of the Office of the Comptroller and adjourned Board of Estimates meetings.

Please note, requests for background documentation for Board of Estimates meetings is not included in these reports. Those requests are handled internally in the interest of expediency and transparency, with a simple review from Law and Comptroller staff, so that the information can be produced within 24 hours of the request.

Between July and December 2025, the Office of the Comptroller **received 17 official PIA requests** and averaged **4 business days for fulfillment**.
