

M. H. Sprague Dies In Iowa

GRAFTON, N. D. (AP) — Manville H. Sprague, 68, former banker here, died Thursday at Council Bluffs, Ia.

Services will be here at 2 Sunday. Burial will be in Crescent Cemetery, with Masonic and military rites.

Born in Grafton, Mr. Sprague was connected with the First National Bank here until 1929. He was in the finance business at the time of his death.

Survivors are his wife, the former Edna Knatvold; two daughters, Mrs. Howard Upton, Minneapolis, and Mrs. Sylvester Rose, Chicago; his mother, Mrs. Frank H. Sprague, Council Bluffs; a brother, Leonard Sprague, Milwaukee, and a sister, Mrs. Lucille Eggers, Council Bluffs.

Mr. Sprague served in the first World War in France, was the first commander of the American Legion post here, and a member of Masonic bodies.
