**DEPENDENT DEFINITION:** Legal spouse and unmarried children to age 20, or 26 if unmarried and a full-time student.

<u>PRE-DETERMINATION:</u> When a course of treatment is expected to cost \$200 or more and is of a non-emergency nature, have your Dentist submit a treatment plan before he/she begins.

<u>LATE ENTRANTS:</u> A late entrant is an employee or dependent who does not enroll on the plan within the 31 days after becoming eligible. A late entrant is subject to the following waiting periods before certain services will be covered:

Covered after insured under the plan 12 months

\*\* Crowns, Inlays, onlays and Labial Veneers are covered only when needed because of decay or injury and only when the tooth cannot be restored with amalgam or composite filling material. When Orthodontia coverage is for "Child(ren)" only, the orthodontic appliance must be placed prior to the age of 19; full-time student age does not apply to the initial placement of the appliance. Orthodontic maintenance may continue as long as full-time student status is maintained. If Orthodontia coverage is for "Adults and Child(ren)" this limitation does not apply. The total number of cleanings and periodontal maintenance procedures are combined in a 12 month period.

All out-of-network benefits are based on usual, customary and reasonable rates for a given area.
