Award

These scholarships will cover **\$30,000** of tuition charges divided equally, over the next two years, as long as the recipient remains in good academic standing.

2. Submit your completed application for the above named Scholarships to the Office of Financial Aid at Bank Street College. Submit by deadline date as stated above.
3. Describe any outside scholarships, grants or resources you will be using to help with the cost of graduate school. Attach your answer to this application.
4. Respond to the following question on separate paper. Describe your vision for working with children. What do you hope to accomplish in your work as an educator? How will your work make a difference in the lives of others? (response not to exceed two pages, single-spaced).
