National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance - Domestic Market Highlights Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady on whole birds and WOGS. Supplies are adequate. Demand is moderate. Processing schedules are normal. Floor stocks are

mostly balanced. Market activity is moderate. In the parts structure, prices remain firm for boneless breasts and tenders, wings are mostly steady to firm and the remaining white and dark meat parts are steady. Supplies of bone-in breasts and fronts are moderate; tenders and MSC are well cleared. Demand is moderate. Market activity is moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate. Weights are sufficient with some issues mentioned on weights being slightly under what is desired.



# **Broiler Hatchery**

#### Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 2 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 247 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 13, 2024, up 2 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 78.9 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three-weeks earlier.

## Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 2 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 190 million chicks for meat production during the week ending April 13, 2024, up 2 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 6, 2024 through April 13, 2024 for the United States were 2.81 billion. Cumulative placements were up slightly from the same period a year earlier.
