---PECANS: The next pecan report is scheduled to be released on Thursday, February 6, 2025.

Prices are for (late afternoon Thursday, January 30, 2025 thru Tuesday, February 4, 2025), in-shell of generally good quality in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.

Growers are finished with harvest, and most are finished for the season. Several growers did not pick up nuts due to quality and low prices offered for pecans. Some growers collected crop insurance, versus harvesting pecans.
