Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers were both too lightly tested this week to develop any market trend. Feeder quality this week was mostly plain to average. Demand for feeders was mostly good, despite a low quality and light offering. Market activity was mostly moderate to active today. Weigh up cows sold on moderate to good demand for moderate offerings. Demand for slaughter cows was mostly moderate as packers tried to purchase a portion of the cow offering for immediate harvest. Slaughter cows were too lightly tested last week to develop an accurate market trend, however steady to higher undertones were noticed. Feeding demand was good to very good again this week which kept prices mostly over slaughter ticket prices. Feeding cows sold on good to very good demand as private feeders and packer buyers both showed good demand for high quality cows to feed. Feeding cows sold mostly steady to 3.00 higher in a narrow comparison. Quality this week was average to very attractive, and slightly better than last week. Weigh up conditions were average to above average this week as many cows were empty coming off grass. Slaughter bulls sold on moderate to good demand this week. Slaughter bulls sold generally steady to 3.00 higher in a narrow comparison. Bull quality was average to attractive this week. Young cows suitable to feed or rebreed sold on very good demand for light to moderate offerings. Most offerings sold 10.00-12.00 higher. Quality was mostly average to very attractive today. A larger portion of the young cow offering was comprised of wet bagged cows this week, for which buyers showed very good demand. Very little difference in price was seen between 2 and 3 year old cows which had lost calves as demand for rebreed and recip cows remains very good. Supply included: 7% Feeder Cattle (32% Steers, 23% Heifers, 45% Bulls); 50% Slaughter Cattle (90% Cows, 10% Bulls); 42% Replacement Cattle (91% Stock Cows, 9% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 70%.
