The expected movement is for the period of September 7 through September 20, 2025. Prices are for Monday, September 8, compared to Tuesday, September 2, 2025, unless otherwise stated. Unless otherwise stated, sales are F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis (including Delivered Sales, F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis) or port of entry, and extra services are included. Prices represent open (spot) market sales by first handlers on products of generally good quality and condition unless otherwise stated and may include promotional allowances or other incentives. No consideration is given to after-sale adjustments unless otherwise stated.
