Demand was moderate to very good from the buyers in the crowd with internet activity noticed. Most of the bawling calves had received one round of pre-weaning vaccinations this fall, those that had not sold at a discount. Supply included: 91% Feeder Cattle (56% Steers, 44% Heifers); 9% Slaughter Cattle (100% Cows). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 63%.
