
Receipts:	This Week	Last Week	Year Ago

Compared to last week, many of your large volume sales were closed last week due to the winter storm and receipts this week were still on the light side, especially at Oklahoma City and Joplin as many auctions this week are compared to two weeks ago. Many of these auctions sold calves mostly 10.00-20.00 higher, with many compared to last week trading not far behind at 5.00-15.00 higher and yearling feeders fully steady to 10.00 higher. Price ranges and trends remain very wide depending on location, local demand, weather, quality and condition. The extreme cold and snow from last week's storm have moved out warmed up and allowed producers to ship cattle and were met by eager demand from buyers. It appears to be a bullish storm for the market. Lot of feeders this week had good weighing conditions coming through the extreme cold and snow of last week. Backgrounder are not hiding their desire to own feeders especially for grazing as demand for these remains very good. Buyers want feeders, calves or yearlings and the better kind top quality bring the top prices. Buyers are determined to own cattle and have them on hand to market later. On Monday at Callaway Livestock Auction in Kingdom City, MO sold 63 steers weighing 713 lbs at 424.00. Tuesday at the Kingsville Livestock Auction in Kingsville, MO sold 367 hd of 800-850 lb steers averaging 834 lbs for a weighted average price of 374.81. On Tuesday at Beaver Livestock in Beaver, OK sold nearly 300 hd of fancy steers, averaging 802 lbs at 373.32. Wednesday in Aberdeen, SD at the Hub City Livestock Market sold 494 steers from 750-800 lbs averaging 775 lbs for a weighted average price of 396.98 and 500 hd of steers weighing from 900-950 lbs averaging 927 lbs for a weighted average price of 356.95. In Torrington, Wy on Wednesday at the Torrington Livestock Auction sold 154 hd of steer calves weighing 400-450 lbs averaging 418 lbs for a weighted average price of 638.39 and 211 hd of steer calves averaging 467 lbs for a weighted average price of 573.95. Ogallala Livestock on Thursday in Ogallala, NE sold 54hd of NHTC steer calves weighing 384 lbs at 650.00. Thursday in Napoleon, ND at Napoleon Livestock Market sold 104 hd of fancy steers weighing 606 lbs at 480.00. Then on Friday, packers pushed bids to 245.00 new cash highs in Kansas and Texas to complete their trade with prices ranging from 242.00-245.00 in the Southern Plains. [More.....](#)







CME FEEDER CATTLE INDEX (\$/CWT)




NATIONWIDE REPORTED WEEKLY FEEDER CATTLE AUCTION RECEIPTS


