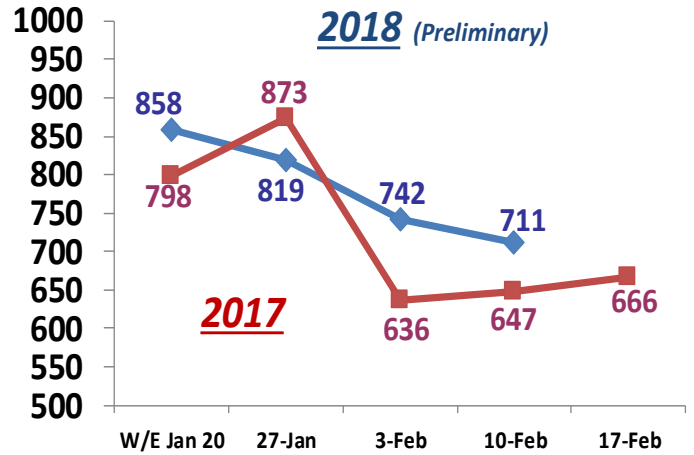




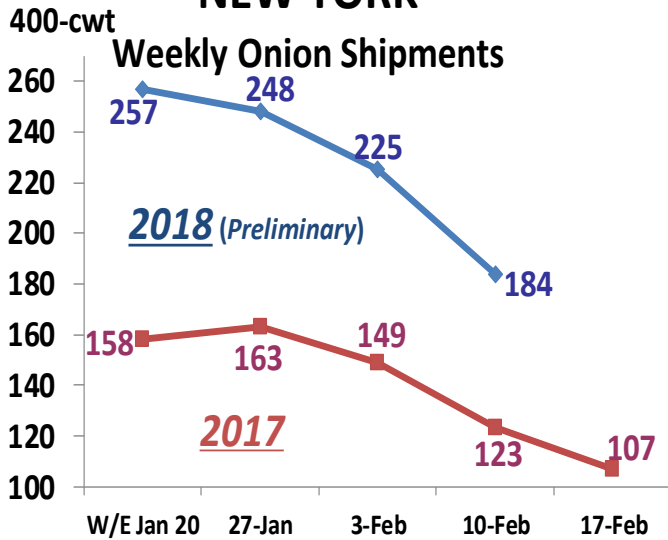
### IDAHO & MALHEUR COUNTY, OR 400-cwt Weekly Onion Shipments



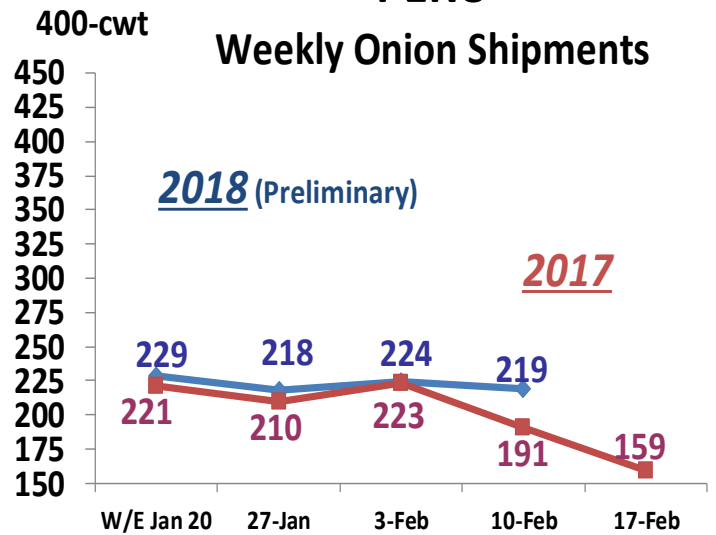

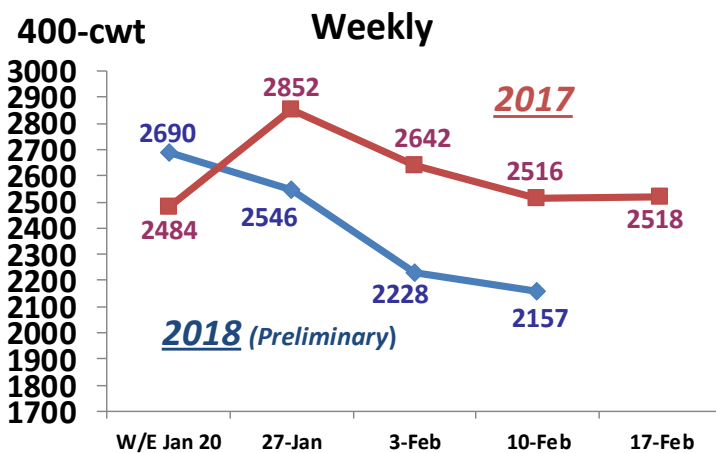

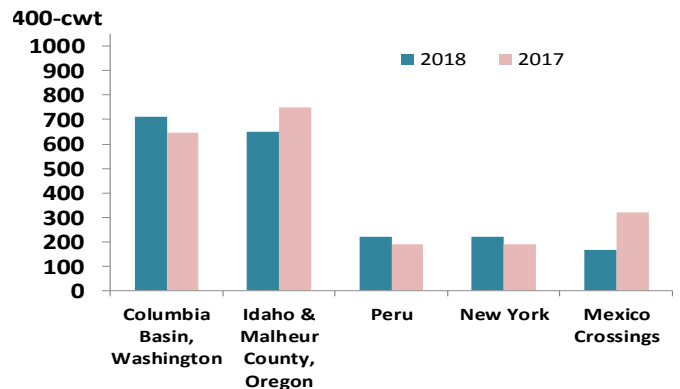
