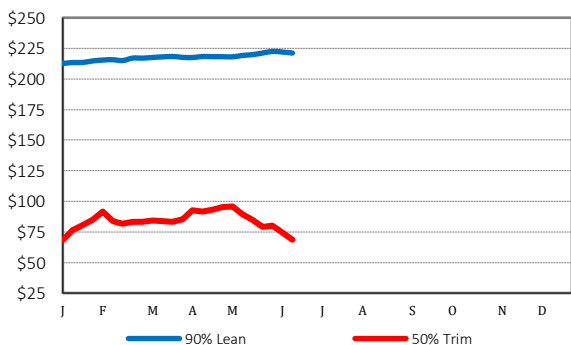

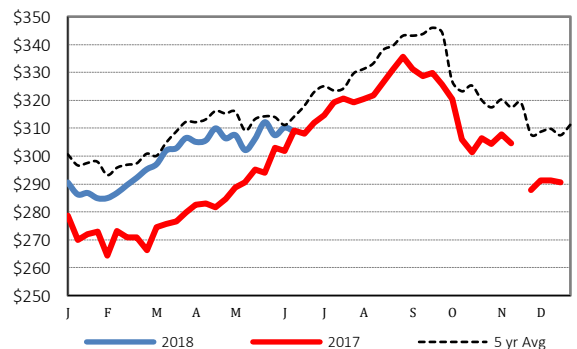

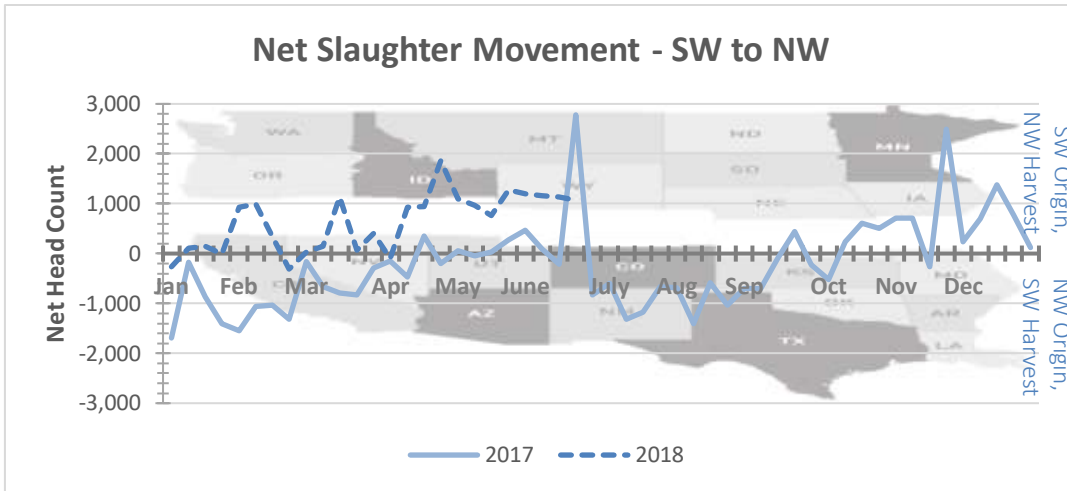

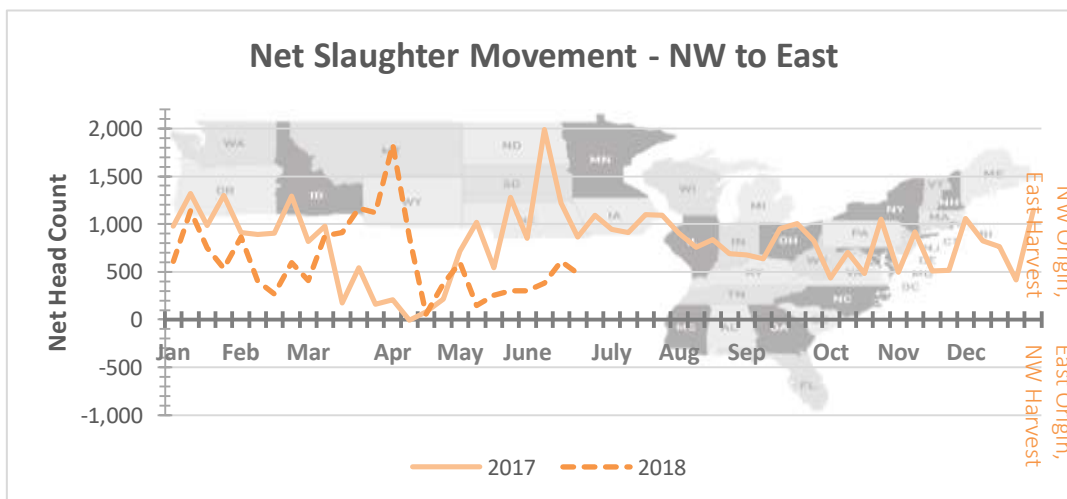
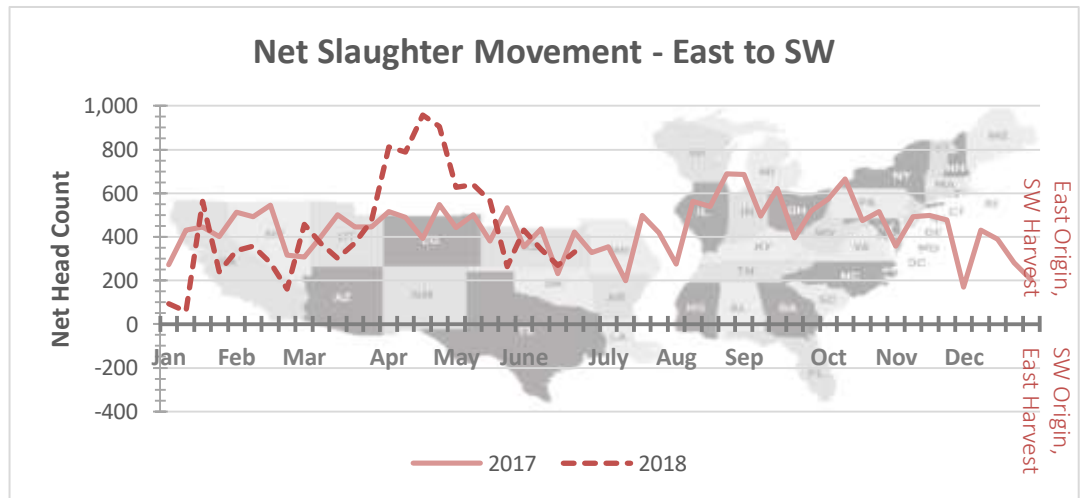
Net Slaughter Movement of Cows and Bulls
