



The Shell Egg Demand Indicator for this week is 0.60 , down 11.1 points from last week.

This Week:

CORRECTED REPORT

Demand for shell eggs continues to move lower but increasing retail promotions are expected to reverse the trend into next week. . Wholesale prices are weak to lower as supplies remain at moderate to heavy levels and offerings remain moderate. Trading is slow to moderate. Breaking stock prices are lower on moderate supplies. Offerings are light to moderate indicating an increase in carton business. Trading is slow to moderate on full-time schedules. The preliminary sample of retail shell egg featuring indicates rising activity and a decreasing average ad price as promotions start to kick in. The holiday baking season is underway with an emphasis on conventional types and on volume purchasing.

Current Days of Shell Eggs on Hand for Marketing -

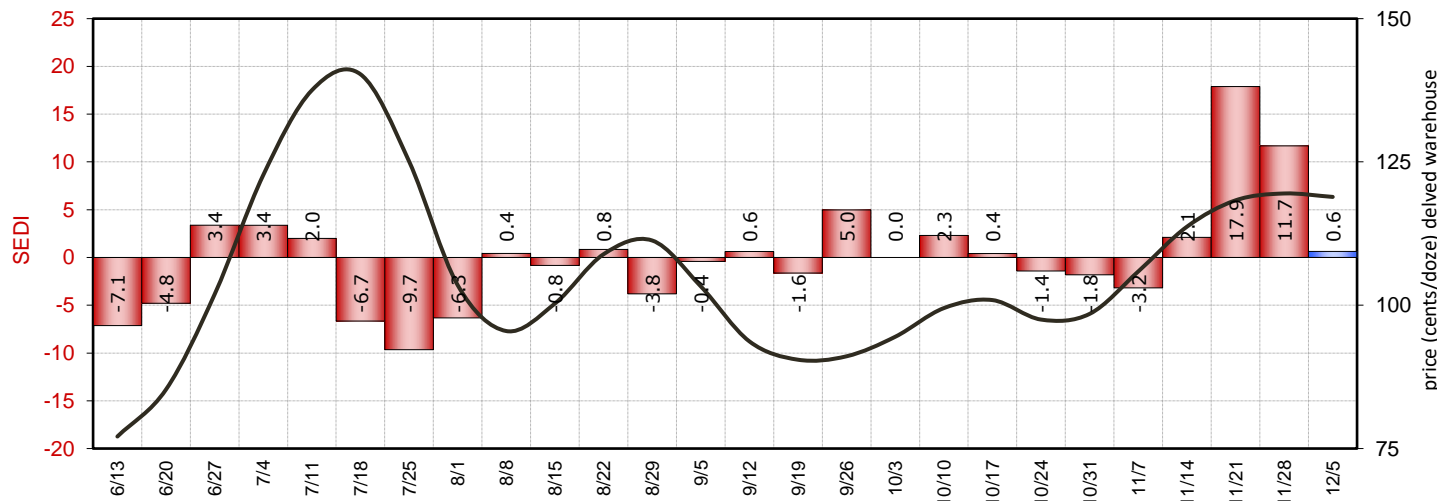
