Receipts: This Week 38,500 Last Week 31,000 Year Ago 42,300

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold unevenly steady. Trade was fairly active on moderate to good demand. Roller coaster of temperatures throughout the week with no moisture in sight. Feeder steers and heifers sold steady to 3.00 higher. Trade was fairly active on moderate to good demand. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady on a light test. Alfalfa sold steady to 5.00 lower. All other hay classes traded mostly steady. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were 3 to 6 cents lower on grain sorghum; mostly 1 to 5 cents lower on wheat; mostly 2 to 3 cents lower on corn.

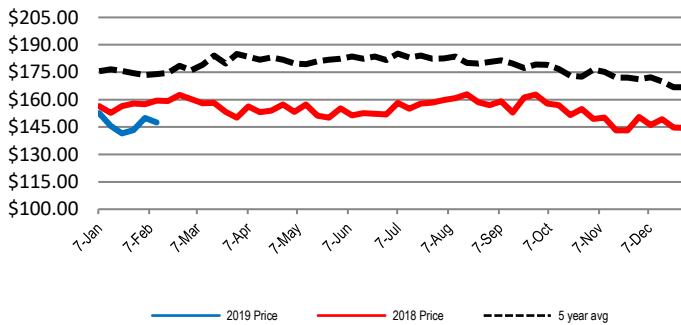

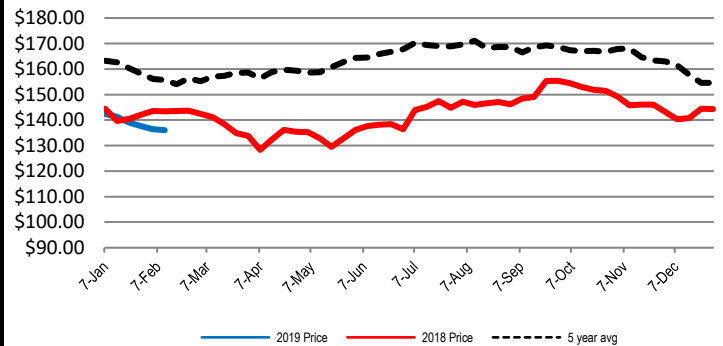
