



# Barnes Art Adventures—Pre-K-1

## Explore and Create

Early learners experience an interactive show that uses art to explore new ideas, places, and cultures. Students will look at nature in art—including depictions of plants, animals, and real or imaginary landscapes—and even find out what it means to try something new. Episodes feature art, stories, and characters from diverse backgrounds and perspectives.

In each episode, a story is read aloud and followed by a discussion about artwork where students are introduced to key concepts and vocabulary. Students and adults work together to respond to the show's activities, and grown-ups can use the chat feature to share the child's experiences during the show. Teachers can explore more with postshow materials to use with students or to share with families at home. *Runtime: 30 minutes*

### **EPISODE 1: EXPLORING FEELINGS—BEING BRAVE**

Thursdays, October 8 and 22, 9–9:30 am

Students will explore what it means to try something new and learn how artists experiment with new ideas and materials.

### **EPISODE 2: EXPLORING NATURE—IMAGINARY WORLDS AND LANDSCAPES**

Thursdays, November 5 and 19, 9–9:30 am

Discover the artist Henri Rousseau and explore imaginary worlds and landscapes.

### **EPISODE 3: EXPLORING NATURE—BIRDS**

Thursdays, December 3 and 17, 9–9:30 am

Students will investigate some of the many bird artworks in the Barnes collection and make connections to places around the world.
