







WHEREAS, in addition to being the owner and operator of two public accounting firms, **Mrs. Fields** was also an active member of the community serving her local church in various capacities, holding office at Local, District, Conference, and State levels, as well as being involved with many civic organizations including the NAACP, the Rotary Club of Live Oak, the Girls and Boys Club, and the Past Matron of the Order of Eastern Stars, PHA; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Fields was elected in 1990 to the Barnwell County Council where she served as Vice Chair of County Council, making her a rich part of South Carolina history as the first and only black woman elected to Council.
