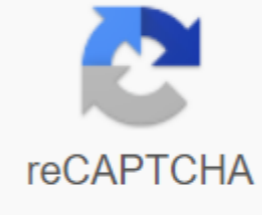

Quotation marks are often used to quote or refer to sentences that are copied from an article, magazine, or book. The quotation marks indicate the cited or textual evidence. Additionally, quotation marks are used for dialogue between two characters or people. Quotation marks show one person or a character talking to another.
