Applying for Joint Admission:

This form is to be completed by Community College of Rhode Island students earning a minimum of 2.0 cumulative grade point average, and a minimum of 24 semester credits prior to enrolling at Bay Path University. Students seeking joint admission into specialized programs, including, but not limited to, occupational therapy, and forensic science, must satisfy all program requirements and earn the minimum cumulative grade point average established for those programs.

1. *When do I submit this form?* You are encouraged to send your forms early. In a given year, some majors may be especially popular and reach their maximum enrollment early.
2. *Where should I send this form?* Once you complete each item on this form, send it to: Office of Transfer Admissions, Bay Path University, 588 Longmeadow Street, Longmeadow, MA 01106
3. *Is there anything else I need to do?* Immediately request an official copy of your academic transcript from the registrar's office at Community College of Rhode Island and send it to Bay Path University admissions office. Once you have finished your last semester at Community College of Rhode Island, please request another official transcript that shows you have graduated and forward it to the BPU admissions office.

Other Enrollment Information:

- o You should contact BPU to determine whether more information is required to complete your application process.

- o If you were previously enrolled at BPU, you are NOT eligible for joint admission.
- o If you have attended another college since completing your degree, you are not eligible for joint admission and should submit a BPU application for admission.
