

Yard Sale Policies

1. Table size is 2 ½ ft. (30 in.) wide x 6 ft. (72 in.) long x 2 ½ ft. (30 in.) tall. Booth space is 10 ft. x 10 ft. with three tables (may be various sizes).
2. Space behind, under and in front of your table(s) is limited, therefore, only persons working your table should be behind your table.
3. All items must fit ON and UNDER the tables (not in the aisles or in front of the tables), or completely within the booth space rented. Items outside of designated areas will be subject to removal.
4. NO FOOD, BEVERAGES OR SNACK ITEMS MAY BE SOLD. Outside food and drinks are not permitted in the building. Civic Center concession stands will be open.
5. NO AMMUNITION, FIREARMS, KNIVES, ALCOHOL, DRUGS OR DRUG PARAPHERNALIA, LIVE ANIMALS OR LEWD OR INDECENT ITEMS ARE TO BE SOLD.
6. No vehicles are allowed in the building. Everything must be carried in through the BACK OF THE BUILDING. Each vendor will be allowed a reasonable amount of time to unload their wares (approx. 20 minutes).
7. Set-up runs from 6-8 a.m. the day of the event. SELLERS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO LOAD IN AFTER 8 A.M. Sellers who purchased the early set-up option can load in the Friday prior to the event from 4-8 p.m. Load and unload at the BACK OVERHEAD DOOR only.
8. Sale hours are 9 a.m.-2 p.m. SELLERS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO EXIT BEFORE 2 P.M. Any unsold items must be removed by 4 p.m.
9. Vendors are encouraged to bring their own cart or hand truck for loading and unloading. Carts are NOT included in your table/booth rental.
10. You are responsible for your items for sale, your personal property and your money. The Civic Center and Wicomico County are not responsible for any items lost, misplaced, damaged or stolen. PLEASE TAKE CARE OF YOUR PROPERTY.
11. There is an admission charge for buyers of \$3 per person. Children under 12 are free.
12. Bring this information sheet and your ID on the day of the sale.
13. A completed Business Affidavit or Trader's License is required to sell at this event unless you are solely selling personal items. Violators will be prohibited from selling at this event and could potentially receive a FINE from the Maryland State Comptroller's Office.
