Butch Waller Scholarship Criteria

Purpose:

Butch Waller is a legend of basketball on Delmarva and this scholarship is to honor his legacy as one of the consistent and winningest coach in MD Public School history. Butch Waller has touched the lives of thousands in the Delmarva community.

The Butch Waller Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to college-bound high school seniors based on demonstrated consistency, academic and athletic achievement, and an expressed interest in pursuing further education.

Criteria:

- The students eligible for assistance must be graduating high school seniors who reside in Maryland or Delaware and have attended a Bayside, Henlopen or ESIAC conference high school.
- They must intend to continue their education at a college, university, vocational or trade school.
- Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need and the student's community service record.
- Students should submit a scholarship application on the form provided by the Butch Waller Scholarship Committee. Return pages 2 & 3 below.
- In addition to completing the scholarship application additional requirements include:
 - Copy of Parent(s) / Guardian(s) previous years tax return.
 - Two (2) letters of recommendation.
 - Written Narrative (recommended 250-500 words) explaining your accomplishments and future plans.
 - Optional 60 second or less video explaining your accomplishments and future plans.

Guidelines: Scholarships will be awarded at an on-court ceremony at the Governors Challenge Basketball Tournament in December on Dec. 29, 2024. Payment would be disbursed in one payment directly to the institution of recipient's choice.

Amount: Each scholarship awarded – One (1) Male and One (1) Female - will be a one-time \$1,000 scholarship.
