Hangar Painting Update- Painting will begin in the spring with a new paint contractor. We will require access to your hangar. SBY Staff will escort the contractor at all times. We cannot accommodate individually requested times for installation.

UAS/Drone Center for Innovation- Construction will start late spring. Contract should be awarded by the end of next week- MDE has changed their criteria for wetlands- We are working with MDE to resolve storm water management issues and the delineation of the wetlands.

Box Hangars- Contract was awarded last summer. Contractor will not start construction at SBY until we have a maintenance facility. Contractor cannot get any pre-construction commitments due to this issue.
