

Scavenger Hunt Rules of Participation

July 13 – August 2 | During Tournament Play

❖ Overview

Get ready to play *on and off the field*! We're hosting a three-week-long scavenger hunt during the softball tournament, open to all participating teams. Gather your squad, complete challenges, and rack up points each week!

Dates

- Week 1: July 13 – July 19
- Week 2: July 20 – July 26
- Week 3: July 27 – August 2

How to Participate

1. Download the Goosechase app

2. Look for your week's scavenger hunt by entering the Join Code (the experience will not be live until sometime in June)
 - a) Week 1: July 13 – July 19 – Join Code: [FIC829](#)

 - c) Week 3: July 27 – August 2 – Join Code: [LTQ5AQ](#)
3. Enter password to join the experience: USSSA2026
4. Find your team name and join your team
 - a) Please make sure to join your existing team and do not create a new one. The organizers will not be able to merge team scores after the hunt ends. If you don't see your team listed, contact Lsoper@wicomicounty.org, and she will add it for you.
5. Teams can have unlimited participants—tackle missions together as a team or individually, as designed!
6. Missions have 3 structures
 - a) Camera: photo or video submission
 - b) Text: text-based answers
 - c) GPS: locational check-ins
7. Complete as many missions as you can to earn points.
8. Track your points throughout the week – weekly leaderboards will be posted!

Prizes

- Grand Prize: Awarded to the team with the highest cumulative score across all three weeks.
 - o In the event of a tie, a tie-breaker determined by the event organizers will be issued to all tied teams within 72 hours of the completion of the Scavenger Hunt. The tie-breaker will be shared equally with all eligible teams and will be designed to ensure a fair and transparent outcome.
- Weekly Prize Drawings:
 - o One prize drawing for each week of play. For every 1,000 points a team earns, they receive one entry into a random prize drawing. For example, 1,000 points earns 1

entry, 3,000 points earns 3 entries, and 15,000 points earns 15 entries. The more points a team earns, the more entries they receive.

Scavenger Hunt Terms of Use & Photo Release Agreement

By participating in the Scavenger Hunt (the “Event”), all participants agree to the following terms:

1. Eligibility

- Participants must be registered members of a USSSA Eastern Nationals tournament team, or their parent/guardian.
- There is no age restriction, but participants under 18 must have permission from a parent or legal guardian.

2. Participation Rules

- All entries must be completed in good faith and in accordance with the Event rules provided each week.
- Teams may consist of an unlimited number of participants.
- Participants may complete tasks individually or as a group, depending on the nature of the challenge.
- Any form of cheating, inappropriate conduct, or rule violations may result in disqualification. No AI-generated submissions will be accepted.
- Respect Boundaries: No missions should involve trespassing, entering restricted areas, or violating park/tournament rules.
- Community Courtesy: Teams should avoid disrupting games, staff, or spectators while completing missions.
- Time Limits: Some missions may be time-bound—be sure to complete and submit them within the posted deadlines for full credit.
- All scoring decisions and prize determinations made by the Event organizers are final.
- Organizers reserve the right to amend rules or missions as needed to ensure fairness and safety.
- One submission per team per mission unless otherwise specified.
- Event organizers reserve the right to adjust scores or reject submissions if a team’s entry does not clearly fulfill the intent of the mission.
- Event organizers will not pay any fees, nor pay any costs relating to, participation in any contest or for the use of any submissions in relation to the scavenger hunt
- Siblings, guardians, and others associated with registered players of the USSSA Eastern Nationals may participate in accomplishing missions; however, each mission submission must include participation from a USSSA Eastern Nationals player. Some missions may be limited to Eastern Nationals players only and will be clearly identified as such.

3. Liability Waiver

By participating in the Event, you acknowledge and agree that:

- Participation is voluntary and at your own risk.
- Event organizers, sponsors, and affiliated partners are not responsible for any injury, loss, or damage sustained during participation.
- You are solely responsible for your actions and safety while participating.

4. Submission Usage

- By entering, all entrants grant to Wicomico County and J&J Consulting dba East Coast Events the irrevocable, perpetual, worldwide right, currently and in the future, in any media or on

any merchandise. to: (i) reproduce, distribute, and display any photo entered in the contest, and (ii) to modify and create derivative works of any photo entered in the contest.

- Entries become the property of Wicomico County and J&J Consulting dba East Coast Events when submitted and will not be returned.
- We may terminate or modify any part of the contest at any time for any reason.
- We may disqualify anyone who violates these Official Rules.
- By entering, all entrants agree to release and indemnify Wicomico County and J&J Consulting (dba East Coast Events) its agents and employees from all claims related to the contest and the present or future use of the photos submitted.

5. Photo & Video Release

By participating in the Event, you consent to the following:

- Your image, voice, and/or likeness may be photographed, recorded, or captured in video by Event organizers or third parties during participation.
- These materials may be used by the Event organizers for promotional, advertising, or marketing purposes without compensation or further approval.
- If you do not wish to be photographed or recorded, please notify the Event staff in writing prior to participation.

6. Privacy

- Personal information collected during registration will be used solely for Event administration and prize distribution, and will not be sold or shared with third parties.

7. Agreement

Participation in the Scavenger Hunt constitutes acceptance of these Terms of Use and Photo Release. If you do not agree with these terms, please refrain from participating in the Event.
