

# ✠ 21 DAYS OF PRAYER AND FASTING

(January 11 - 31, 2021)

2021 is our year of “**With God, all things are possible!**”! As a church, we are taking 21 days to pray and seek God for our church, families, personal walk with God and our nation.

Pastor Keith announced on December 31, that our word of the year is POSSIBLE! Our scripture is **Luke 1:37**, *For with God nothing is impossible*. What do you want to be “**possible**” this year?

**In addition to a daily time of prayer, we invite you to join us in fasting during the next 21 days!** Fasting is simply abstaining from something to focus that time on God. We ask that you partner with us during the 21 days, as we corporately pray and fast and adhere our hearts to God’s. As we do this, we are believing for miracles and answers to prayer.

When fasting, you should approach it individually as it looks different for everyone. Please choose what is a safe and healthy choice for you and consult your physician if you have a medical condition that could be affected by fasting.

## TYPES OF FASTS

-  Liquid Fast – Fast solid foods – *Jesus, Moses, Elijah*
-  Daniel Fast – Eat Fruits and Vegetables – *Daniel*
-  7 Day Fast – Fast all or specific foods for 7 days
-  Sunup – Sundown Fast – Liquids only from sunup to sundown
-  Lunch Fast – Fast lunch each day
-  Daily Fast – Fast one day a week
-  Social Media Fast – Fast social media, spending, entertainment, etc. (whatever the Lord places on your heart)

## Daily Prayer Points and Scriptures

**DAY 1: JANUARY 11** Your Kingdom come; your will be done. (For ELC)

**Matthew 6:10 (TPT)** *Manifest your kingdom realm and cause your every purpose to be fulfilled on earth, just as it is fulfilled in heaven.*

**DAY 2: JANUARY 12** Having a heart of gratitude for all that God has done. \*Make a gratitude list today (Thanksgiving is prayer)

**Psalms 100:4 (KJV)** *Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise: be thankful unto Him and bless His name.*

**Colossians 3:15 (TPT)** *Let your heart be always guided by the peace of the Anointed One, who called you to peace as part of his one body. And always be thankful.*

**DAY 3: JANUARY 13** Place God first in your priorities.

**Matthew 6:33** *But first and most importantly seek (aim at, strive after) His kingdom and His righteousness [His way of doing and being right—the attitude and character of God], and all these things will be given to you also.*

**DAY 4: JANUARY 14** Cleanse me from everything not in obedience with His will and purposes.

**1 John 1:9 (AMP)** *If we [freely] admit that we have sinned and confess our sins, He is faithful and just [true to His own nature and promises] and will forgive our sins and cleanse us continually from all unrighteousness [our wrongdoing, everything not in conformity with His will and purpose].*

**Romans 12:2 (NKJV)** *And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.*

**DAY 5: JANUARY 15** Pray that the enemy has no claim on you, no power over you or anything that he can use against you.

**John 14:30** *I will not speak with you much longer, for the ruler of the world (Satan) is coming. And he has no claim on Me [no power over Me, nor anything that he can use against Me.*

**DAY 6: JANUARY 16** Pray- as the church, we will preach the gospel of the kingdom with boldness. (Freedom)

**Matthew 4:23 (AMPC)** *And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and preaching the good news (Gospel) of the kingdom, and healing every disease and every weakness and infirmity among the people.*

**DAY 7: JANUARY 17** Pray for your family and your home. (Marriage and Family)

**Nehemiah 4:13-14 (NLT)** *13 So I placed armed guards behind the lowest parts of the wall in the exposed areas. I stationed the people to stand guard by families, armed with swords, spears, and bows. 14 Then as I looked over the situation, I called together the nobles and the rest of the people and said to them, "Don't be afraid of the enemy! Remember the Lord, who is great and glorious, and fight for your brothers, your sons, your daughters, your wives, and your homes!"*

**DAY 8: JANUARY 18** Pray for God's people to continue to be a light and voice in their local and national government. (Outreach)

**Matthew 5:14-16** *You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead, they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.*

**Psalms 33:12 (NKJV)** *Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people He has chosen as His own inheritance.*

**DAY 9: JANUARY 19** Declare blessings and new territories over your life in 2021. (Prosperity and Favor)

**1 Chronicles 4:10 (NIV)** *Jabez cried out to the God of Israel, "Oh, that you would bless me and enlarge my territory! Let your hand be with me and keep me from harm so that I will be free from pain." And God granted his request!*

**Numbers 6:24-25 (NKJV)** *24 "The LORD bless you and keep you; 25 The LORD make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you;*

**DAY 10: JANUARY 20** We declare grace, peace, and mercy over our nation. Bring truth, justice, righteous laws & freedom/religion.

**Psalms 44:26 (NIV)** *Rise up and help us; rescue us because of your unfailing love.*

**Isaiah 51:5 (NLT)** *My mercy and justice are coming soon. My salvation is on the way. My strong arm will bring justice to the nations. All distant lands will look to me and wait in hope for my powerful arm.*

**DAY 11: JANUARY 21** Pray for a fresh spiritual awakening in our church, our city, and our nation.

**Acts 2:17-21 (MSG)** *"In the Last Days," God says, "I will pour out my Spirit on every kind of people: Your sons will prophesy, also your daughters; your young men will see visions, your old men dream dreams. When the time comes, I will pour out my Spirit on those who serve me, men and women both, and they'll prophesy. I'll set wonders in the sky above and signs on the earth below. And whoever calls out for help to me, God, will be saved."*

**DAY 12: JANUARY 22** That you will have a hunger for God's presence. (Know God)

**Psalms 9:10:** *Those who know your name trust in You, for You, Lord, have never forsaken those who seek You.*

**Jeremiah 29:13:** *You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.*

**1 Chronicles 29:13:** *Now devote your heart and soul to seeking the Lord your God.*

**DAY 13: JANUARY 23** Overcoming anxiety with His peace.

**Philippians 4:6-7 (NASB)** *Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your request be made know to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*

**DAY 14: JANUARY 24** Healing of a divided nation. (Loving people)

**Colossians 3:10-14 (NIV)** *and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator. 11 Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all. 12 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. 13 Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. 14 And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity*

**DAY 15: JANAURY 25** Choose today to walk in love rather than fear.

**2 Timothy 1:7 (AMP)** *For God did not give us a spirit of timidity or cowardice or fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment and personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind, and self-control].*

**John 15:12** *This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you.*

**Proverbs 29:25 (TPT)** *Fear and intimidation is a trap that holds you back. But when you place your confidence in the Lord, you will be seated in the high place.*

**DAY 16: JANAURY 26** Invite Him into - what you are believing for today. (Invite Him In)

**Proverbs 3:5-8 (TPT)** *5 Trust in the Lord completely, and do not rely on your own opinions. With all your heart rely on him to guide you, and he will lead you in every decision you make. 6 Become intimate with him in whatever you do, and he will lead you wherever you go. 7 Don't think for a moment that you know it all, for wisdom comes when you adore him with undivided devotion and avoid everything that's wrong.*

**DAY 17: JANAURY 27** Become an ambassador (representative) of faith.

**John 14:12 (TPT)** *"I tell you this timeless truth: The person who follows me in faith, believing in me, will do the same mighty miracles that I do—even greater miracles than these because I go to be with my Father!*

**Matthew 9:29 (TPT)** *Then Jesus put his hands over their eyes and said, "You will have what your faith expects!"*

**Matthew 17:20** *So Jesus said to them, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.*

**DAY 18: JANAURY 28** Worship Him: He is the Kingdom, and the Power, and the Glory for ever and ever!  
(Adore Him today, worship is prayer)

**Psalms 141:2-3 (TPT)** *2 Let my prayer be as the evening sacrifice that burns like fragrant incense, rising as my offering to you as I lift up my hands in surrendered worship!*

**Psalms 138:1-3 (MSG)** *Thank you! Everything in me says "Thank you!" Angels listen as I sing my thanks. I kneel in worship facing your holy temple and say it again: "Thank you!" Thank you for your love, thank you for your faithfulness; Most holy is your name, most holy is your Word. The moment I called out, you stepped in, you made my life large with strength.*

**DAY 19: JANAURY 29** Insist that every proud attitude bows in obedience to Christ.

**2 Corinthians 10:4-5 (TPT)** *3-4 For although we live in the natural realm, we don't wage a military campaign employing human weapons, using manipulation to achieve our aims. Instead, our spiritual weapons are energized with divine power to effectively dismantle the defenses behind which people hide. 5 We can demolish every deceptive fantasy that opposes God and breaks through every arrogant attitude that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God. We capture, like prisoners of war, every thought and insist that it bow in obedience to the Anointed One*

**Micah 6:8 (NKJV)** *He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the LORD require of you but to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk (live) humbly with your God?*

**DAY 20: JANAURY 30** For you to continue to become who God has empowered you to become, steady and sure with spiritual confidence. (Grow and show generosity)

**Habakkuk 3:19 (AMP)** *The Lord GOD is my strength [my source of courage, my invincible army] He has made my feet [steady and sure] like hinds' feet. And makes me walk [forward with spiritual confidence] on my high places [of challenge and responsibility]. The troubled times of life may be the "high places" of spiritual growth for the believer who remains stable when tested by God.*

**1 Timothy 6:18-19 (TPT)** *Remind the wealthy to be rich in good works of extravagant generosity, willing to share with others. 19 This will provide a beautiful foundation for their lives and secure for them a great future, as they lay their hands upon the meaning of true life.*

**3 John 1:2 (NKJV)** *Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.*

**DAY 21: JANAURY 31** Today believe that whatever impossible mountain that stands before you will crumble. This is the power of the Holy Spirit at work on your behalf!!

**Luke 1:37** *For with God nothing will be impossible.*

**Zechariah 4:6-7** *6 So he answered and said to me: "This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: "Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit," Says the LORD of hosts.*
