- **The Revere Election Department and Revere CFO have sent a communication email asking if we can use some of the ADA/HP funds collected to help offset costs, to help pay for 10 ADA-compliant voting booths. The cost of each unit is \$999.00 plus an additional Tariff charge of \$149.85. There is also a total shipping charge of \$647.20 to be included, so the final cost for all 10 units delivered would be \$12,135.70.**
