Drainage System Improvements

The work will consist of drainage system replacement in the Library Street and Sewall Street neighborhood. The project will replace aging and undersized drainage infrastructure to improve surface drainage and reduce flooding during high intensity storm events.

The work includes installation of:

- 3,900 linear feet of storm drain
- 54 catch basins
- 50 drain manholes

The City of Revere is pleased to notify you of the upcoming storm drain improvement project in the Library Street and Sewall Street neighborhood. As part of the City's ongoing efforts to improve the drainage system and reduce flooding, Aqua Line Utility, Inc. has been contracted to install the new drainage infrastructure. Drainage installation work is scheduled to begin in May 2026 and will be completed in November 2026. Construction will take place during the day between 7:00 am and 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

The City's engineering consultant, Weston & Sampson Engineers, will employ an on-site resident project representative throughout the project.
