As you explore, you'll hear the compelling story of the Battle of Halfway Swamp in Pinewood and the skirmish that followed at Poinsett, bringing this chapter of local history to life.

Along the way, enjoy three memorable stops—the Historic Overlook Shelter, Singleton's Grist Mill, and the Coquina Shelter—where you'll discover the mill's role in the American Revolution and how the Civilian Conservation Corps helped preserve these sites. Join us for a day of fresh air, storytelling, and meaningful connection to the past!
