



Subject: 30" Heavy Duty Rotary Mower Blade Adjustment

The blade location of the 30" Heavy Duty Rotary Mower comes standard in its lowest position. For use on a rough terrain or to raise the cutting height, the blade position can be raised higher.

To ensure the best discharge possible, BCS recommends that the front caster wheel be located through the bottom hole in the caster support. This will raise the front of the cutting deck as high as possible and enhances the performance of the discharge.

To Raise The Blade Position:

1. Remove the two bolts securing the blade to the hub.
2. Remove the blade and two 1/2" spacers.
3. Position the blade between the spacers, or above both spacers to raise the blade as high as possible.
4. Reinstall the blade using the two bolts and tighten to approximately 75 ft. /lbs.
