■ BDI'S LIFT DESKS ELEVATE THE NOTION OF A STANDING DESK WHILE COMBINING EXECUTIVE-LEVEL DESIGN with premium functionality. The release of its latest office collection from Kronos continues this legacy with distinctive and innovative styling.

Technology advancements have rapidly changed the office landscape, and the country has seen a growth in home-based workers. At BDI, their "working" category represents almost half of the company's sales, a percentage that continues to grow.

Designed by BDI's Matthew Weatherly, the collection includes a standing desk, a multifunction cabinet and a storage credenza. The desk allows the user to sit or stand and the level of the work surface is easily adjusted using a digital keypad. Programmable to four user-defined settings, the work surface is height-adjustable from 24.5 inches to 49.5 inches. The keypad can be mounted on the left or right of the desk per the user's preference.

Kronos natural walnut veneers on the desk's fascia and surround are offset by a satin white, high-pressure laminate desktop that provides a durable and smooth surface. The motorized base's minimal satin white finish puts the attention on the upper levels, providing a floating aesthetic.

With organization in mind, the desk includes an upper shelf where everyday items can be kept. The storage drawer features a flip-down front and nonslip lining, ideal for placement of a keyboard, mouse and rechargeable electronics.

The complementary multifunction cabinet was designed to be the ideal height so it can be easily accessed whether sitting or standing.
