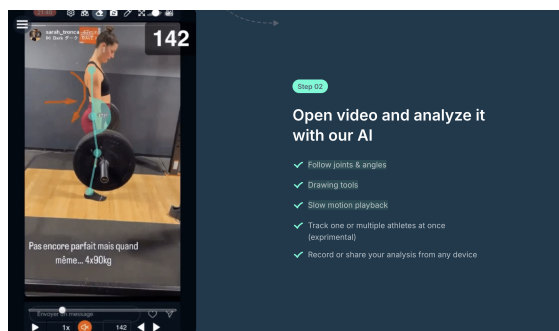

- Drawing tools

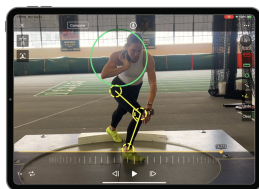
