Wondering how to care for your handmade brass pieces?

Sometimes it can be hard to find an easy and safe way to clean your jewelry. Even for me as a jewelry designer. But working together for many years with professional jewelry artists I discovered an easy way to care for your brass Danpae Jewelry collection.

I HAVE PUT TOGETHER A FEW USEFUL TIPS:

1-Store your jewelry in a sealed plastic bag

Natural brass will oxidize over time turning a darker more muted color. To maintain a shiny bright finish for as long as possible store your jewelry in a sealed plastic bag with an anti-tarnish strip and keep it dry.

2-Avoid humidity

Do not wear in the shower or store in a humid environment.

3-Take off your jewelry

before showering and before applying perfumes, hairsprays, lotions or make-up.

4-Avoid contact with household cleaning products.

These can speed up the tarnishing process.

So how are we going to return brass to it's original color?

FOLLOW THESE EASY STEPS:

1-CLEANING

To return brass to its original natural bright colour. The First thing you need is fresh lemon juice and small drops of dishwashing liquid.

I prefer to use Dreft. Than mix them together.

(!) If your piece of jewellery does not contain a stone you can just lay your jewelry in the cleaning fluid.

--WARNING!

If your jewelry contains Pearls and Faience beads (mostly made from clay), please do not use the lemon juice and dish washing liquid on them, only on the brass parts! Also be careful with this method when your brass jewelry contains semi precious stones.

2-INSTEAD USE THIS

You can use your finger tip to rub in the dishwashing/lemon solution or you can use a cotton bud or a little soft brush to help clean the jewelry. Leave it a few minutes in the the solution but be careful not to leave it too long.



And at last...

3-WATER

Rinse off with water and use a clean dry cloth to finish the cleaning process. After the jewelry is cleaned and dried you can best keep them in a plastic zip-lock air tight bag.
