Amanda Graham: I like to think that's something that's a bit unique about this site20:29

Sharon: May I ask about how something could/would be changed on main screen? Why does it say "If you've

slipped..." that is a tough fight every time it comes up.20:29

Amanda Graham: our intent is NOT to hammer home only THE way to quit20:29

Giulia: @ Amanda - I consider it one of the blessings.20:29

Amanda Graham: but to acknowledge there are MANY ways to quit20:30

Amanda Graham: some may have more "evidence" behind them, and we aim to make that available 20:30

Amanda Graham: but ultimately it's what peoplpe find works for them20:30

Nancy: I agree that there is not one fits all approach.20:30

Amanda Graham: @Sharon20:31

Amanda Graham: can you tell me more about this 20:31 **Giulia**: The "slip button" is really tough for us. 20:31

trick@hotmail.com: What ever works to quit.... we need to quit all20:31

Sharon: yes to G's response20:32 Giulia: I'll continue -20:32 Marilyn H joined the chat20:32

jennifer72113: amanda we feel if you slip and have onepuff you need to restart the clock20:32

Nancy: Sharon - I agree. It is a DECISION to smoke once you have made a decision to quit - and saying you slipped does not, to me, seem like you are held accountable....unless a patch of ice is involved20:32

jennifer72113: your instructions do not say that20:32

Giulia: I believe the majority of the long-term quitters on the site feel that if a slip is put out there right up front, it's an encouragement for failure.20:33

Terrie 07/06/15: or a banna peel20:33

Nancy: Hi, Marilyn from the great frozen North!20:33

Sharon: Hello Canada!20:33 Terrie 07/06/15: Hi Marilyn20:34

Amanda Graham: i wonder if this notion of "restarting" is really an individual decision20:34

Giulia: Sure people slip. And obviously you want to encourage them to come back afterwards to try again.

But to put it s blatently just -...20:34

Amanda Graham: what about focusing this more on "is this still your quit date?"20:34

Amanda Graham: asking someone to verify their quit date... whether or not they have had a puff

afterawrds... but if that is still their identifiied quit date20:35

jennifer72113: i have almost 2 years and that is without a slip20:35

Giulia: Yes.20:35

Amanda Graham: in the research community, there is this notion of a "grace period" 20:35

Sharon: Yes, that makes sense. When do they verify?20:35

Amanda Graham: in measuring abstinence, researchers purposely ask about cigarette use after a quit

date20:35

Terrie 07/06/15: 283 days no slips20:35

Giulia: I don't have a grace period with quitting.20:35

Nancy: Amanda - but what is to discourage a person from doing it again and again and again? We want folks

to have their FINAL quit with us. I think it shouild be called a lapse and relapse.20:35

jennifer72113: i would not feel right celebrating w years if i had slipped even once20:35

Giulia: This is HUGE issue within the community.20:36

Sharon: I would feel ashamed to "fool" my EX family like that.20:36

Terrie 07/06/15: me too Sharon20:36

Amanda Graham: so it sounds like the group here would favor more clear, direct, and firm language about a

quit date that STIKS20:36

Amanda Graham: STICKS20:36

jennifer72113: no offence amanda but the addication does not work this way -20:37

Amanda Graham: agreed20:37

Giulia: No, it's not so much about quit date, it about the psychology of allowing "slips." 20:37

jennifer72113: after almost 2 years if i smoked one tonight- - i could be back at a pack a day in no time at all20:37

Giulia: There's a that big Slip button there. It calls to the addict within.20:38

Sharon: I would too....but I'm going to hang in cuz I am coming to the Quad Squad!20:38

Nancy: Jennifer - exactly! If there is no penance, why not just do it again, and again, and again???20:38 **Dr. Hays**: Most of the studies looking at "lapse" show that they virtually all become "relapse"20:38

Giulia: Of course they do. That's what we're saying!20:39

Giulia: Call it a slip or lapse. What's the difference? You put a cigarette in your mouth.20:39

Amanda Graham: this has been a great discussion20:40 **Amanda Graham**: @Sharon thanks for raising this20:40

Nancy: Dr. Hays - exactly!!!! Thank you.20:40

jennifer72113: so what is the timeline for the new EX?20:40

Terrie 07/06/15: I wouldn't want to keep putting myself through it. Quitting was hard enough to do once.

That's the point I try to make 20:40

Amanda Graham: @jennifer... new community = Fall 201620:40 **Amanda Graham**: new "everything else" Spring-ish 201720:40
