If you have ever wondered about these puzzling scenes, we hope you will join us for a six-week sermon series. It begins January 6, 2019. Patrick will preach the first five Sundays, and Heather will wrap up the series on February 10.

• **January 6:** “In The Beginning Was The...Word?” It sounds like nonsense. Besides, what’s this “word” got to do with us?

• **January 13:** “Born Again?” It sounds like a secret code word that gains entry into heaven! But did Jesus actually say “born again?”
