Join us for a powerful, interactive conversation about Immigration & Cultural Awareness in our community. Carola Otero Bracco, Executive Director of Neighbors Link, will be speaking about the work that she is currently leading in our community including cultural awareness and what's taking place on a national level with regard to immigration policy.

Carola will be joined by other members of Neighbors Link, who are immigrants, and will share their stories and the paths they took to get here. The Neighbors Link mission is to strengthen the whole community through the healthy integration of immigrants. This mission is achieved by filling a service gap for new immigrant families, offering education and empowerment programs, involving longer-term residents in volunteer opportunities and creating substantive partnerships with other local organizations.
