Carl's Dye-a-logue

I once was asked why, as a general rule, on Mother's Day preachers always preached "feel good" sermons, but on Father's Day the sermons were always about what fathers are doing wrong? I did not have an answer for the inquirer, but on the next Mother's Day I preached a "challenging" sermon to mothers and several of the ladies got upset!

Please know that I am not trying to upset anyone. It seems that our ladies have multiple opportunities to fellowship and Bible study. We have a wonderful Ladies Bible Class now meeting at 10:00 AM at the church building on Wednesday. The ladies have prayer sisters. They have Heartfelt Sisters. The ladies attend ladies' days at sister congregations.

The question has, perhaps, been asked or thought about, "What do the men have for them?"

In Proverbs 27:17, the wise man writes, "As iron sharpens iron, so one man sharpens another." With that in mind, I want to announce a new program: "Iron Sharpening Iron." This is a fellowship and Bible study opportunity for men.

This is for ALL of our men (high school aged and up). Dads are *encouraged* to bring their younger sons as well. If you are not in high school and you need a "dad" to bring you, let Doug or me know.

For this to work, we need men who are willing to step up and host these 45 minute to 1 hour studies once a month in your home.
