If you are not interested in the professional football league in the United States currently holding its playoffs, I hope you'll still read this article.

On Saturday, January 14, 2023 the third largest comeback in playoff history for the afore mentioned league took place. The 10-7 Los Angeles Chargers were ahead of the 9-8 Jacksonville Jaguars by 27 points as the first half came to a close.

Jacksonville's quarterback had a terrible first half, throwing four interceptions and showing no ability to move the ball or sustain a drive. But with 24 seconds left, Jacksonville scored a touchdown.

The bottom line is that Jacksonville won the game 31-30 with a field goal as time expired.

What does a wildcard football playoff game have to do with us? That is a fair question . . .

A lot of people probably turned the game off when it was 27-0 in favor of the Chargers. A lot of people missed out because they figured the game was over. A lot of people were surprised when they heard the final score.

Spiritually in our lives, we have downs. Sometimes these downs seem so overwhelming that we want to give up. We see ourselves as down by more than "27 points" and figure the game is over, so we might as well quit.

The Jaguars did not quit. They did not give up. They did not "phone in" the second half. They chipped away at the "insurmountable" lead of the Chargers and, when the game was over, they had won!

Paul put it this way, ". . . forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:13, 14).

When you feel down and out, do not give up: forget what has happened and focus on what can happen and keep on pressing on! Victory is ours if we do not quit (cf. Heb 10:39).
